



INTENT TO SUBMIT

2018 Awards Categories:

Building Engineering: Includes structural, electrical, communications, life-safety, geotechnical and all other services done for the construction of commercial, institutional, and residential buildings.

Infrastructure/Transportation: New for 2018 this category has been separated:

Transportation: Includes all engineering projects that involve bridges, roads, airports and transit lines, etc...

Infrastructure: Includes all engineering projects that involve the physical components of interrelated and fundamental facilities and systems not covered in other categories.

Environmental: Includes contaminated site-clean-ups, solid-hazardous waste handling and treatment plants, wastewater infrastructure and wastewater treatment plants, environmental assessment studies and other special environmental remediation projects.

Energy Resource Development: Includes dams, and power generation & transmission, etc... Also includes studies done for these sectors.

Municipal and Water Technology: Includes water supply/treatment plants, erosion control, and storm water management, etc... Also includes studies done for these sectors.

Industrial: Includes plant buildings, facilities and process engineering related to industrial, mining, fuels, metallurgy, and forestry, etc...

Small Projects: Includes projects that consist of a design, a planning study, a review of practice/standard or an assessment of conditions. Small projects are considered to have an engineering budget not exceeding \$100,000.

Potential for Multiple Awards in each category: The Judging Panel employs a scoring threshold for both the Award of Excellence and the Award of Merit. If more than one project scores above the threshold level of points for an Award of Excellence, then more than one Award of Excellence will be awarded. If more than one project scores higher than the Award of Merit threshold score, then similarly, more than one Merit Award will be issued.

Eligible Projects for ACEC-MB Awards: The Board has decided to allow only full ACEC members to compete in the Consulting Engineers of Manitoba Awards of Excellence. Projects from out of province may be submitted, provided the ACEC Manitoba Submitting firm's local Manitoba office completed at least 75% of the work on the project. Projects must have been completed no later than 2016 to be submitted for consideration for the 2018 Awards .
