ACEC Summit Recap

The ACEC-Canada National Summit was held from June 21-23, 2012 in beautiful Prince Edward Island. This year's theme was *Connecting Leaders, Driving Business*. Bruce Wilton (ACEC-MB Past Chair), Todd Smith (ACEC MB's liaison to the ACEC Canada Board), Owen Van Wallegghem (ACEC-MB YPC Chair), Kyle Shymko (ACEC-MB Image Committee member) and Shirley Tillett (ACEC MB's Executive Director) represented Manitoba at this year's event.



Joint sessions included a keynote address on the speed of innovation, a market trends panel, a panel on risks to our businesses and industry, a presentation on changing demographics, and presentations from each provincial and territorial organization regarding their successes and challenges over the past year.

The keynote speaker was futurist and innovation expert, Jim Carroll, who discussed the ever-increasing growth of knowledge and pace of change in the industry today and in the future. Jim stressed that "the future belongs to those who are fast", and the greatest success will be achieved by those with the ability to quickly recognize and understand new ideas and opportunities, and have the courage to take risks.

The YP sessions included a round table, hosted by the leader of the ACEC National YP Network, Simon Davidson, where YPs were encouraged to discuss issues, challenges and opportunities faced by the YPs in the consulting industry. Another YP session, led by *Professional Integral Coach™*, Cam Greg, focused on choosing your career path as either a future manager or technical expert. The third YP session, led by Andrew Steeves, presented advice and a number of helpful tips on developing lasting professional relationships with clients.

In addition to the many presentations and discussions, the Summit also played host to a number of social and networking events. These events provided attendees with the opportunity to make connections with industry leaders and YPs from right across the country.
