



## ACEC-MB LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

**Purpose:** The Lifetime Achievement Award acknowledges the individual achievements of Manitoba's consulting engineers. This award is presented to a Manitoba engineer in recognition of his or her leadership, achievements and contributions to consulting engineering and the community.

**Eligibility Criteria:** The nominee must meet the following requirements:

- Retired or present member of an ACEC-Manitoba Member Firm (formerly CEM).
- Have carried out major achievements within the organization and the community.
- Have made significant contributions to the advancement of the interests and goals of the profession and of ACEC-MB.

**Selection Criteria:**

- **Service to the Profession:** Describe how the nominee has provided public education and understanding of the role and importance of the profession; and participation in engineering associations, societies, institutes, etc. other than ACEC-MB. Total duration and effectiveness of this service will be considered.
- **Service to the Organization:** Describe how the nominee has actively participated on committees, projects, and other activities that advance the interests and goals of the profession and of ACEC-MB. Total duration and effectiveness of this service will be considered.
- **Service to the Community:** Describe the nominee's past or present involvement with not-for-profit organizations, community organizations and other paid or unpaid work beyond the profession.

**Nomination Procedures**

- Nominations will be accepted from ACEC-MB member firms in good standing.
- There is no limit to the number of nominations that may be submitted from any one firm.
- Individuals may self-nominate for the award.
- Individuals may nominate their peers for the award.
- Entries must include descriptions of the contributions made by the nominee as specified by the selection criteria described above.
- Submissions should be no more than five (5) pages in length, including all supporting evidence.

**Selection Process**

- The nominations will be reviewed and the recipient selected by the ACEC-MB Board of Directors.
- The award will be presented at the ACEC-MBs Annual Awards of Excellence.

## ACEC-MB RISING STAR AWARD

- **Service to the Association:** Describe how the nominee has actively participated on committees, projects, and other activities that advance the interests and goals of the profession and ACEC-MB. Total duration and effectiveness of this service will be considered.
